By working with our friends in the private sector, Utah Water Ways will create the opportunity for next-level public education, programming, and policy discussions about Utah's water reality and future.



POLICY

- Establish a direct line of communication from stakeholders to state leaders
- Governed by a broad set of stakeholders representing government agencies, agriculture, water districts and suppliers, and the private sector



PROGRAM

- Coordinate water conservation efforts and sponsor policy discussion about the state's water supply
- Engage the private sector to help support water conservation efforts
- Help coordinate grants, rebate programs, sponsorships, etc. to support water conservation



PUBLIC

- Conduct public awareness and education campaigns
- Provide tools to help residents understand what they can and should do to take part in conservation
- Maintain water providers' continued promotion of efficient water use among users though localized messaging, rebate programs, etc.
