Dear Utah law makers,

Utah spends \$89,000 per day (\$22 million a year) for dry water paperwork.
Division of Water Rights - \$10 million budget
Division of Water Resources - \$7 million budget
Division of Drinking Water - \$5 million budget.

Over the next 25 years, Utah will spend \$600 million on dry water paperwork.

\$300 million in paperwork savings plus a farm work ethic would get Utah 2 new Jordanelle Reservoirs storing 680,000 acre-feet of water enough water for 2 million new people.

Half the Division of Water Right paperwork is such small amounts of water 2 acre-feet or less.

Some Water Right paperwork for indoor water use has a depletion factor equal to 74 dandelions, a small bush, or a small tree. There are no "dry" parcels in 9 western states unlike Utah hostile towards farmers and private property owners.

Utah spent \$50,000 in water paperwork over 10 years on \$10 worth of water (5,000 gallons), because Salt Lake City uses the State Engineer as a Planning and Zoning trap against canyon development SLC deems unacceptable. Middle class private canyon owners are bullied out of their lands while 4 rich ski resorts get SLC water for 4,000+ canyon houses.
SLC is the only city in Utah with 31,023 acres of land ownership outside its city limits bought for pennies on the dollar because it was "dry."

No land is actually "dry" in Utah despite Utah's Water Cartels insistence every drop of water is owned by the State and controlled by the title owner. It is not. A water right in Utah is water diverted from a described geographic point for a described use.

For example, North 100 feet East 300 feet from the South East Corner of Section 5, Range 2 East, Township 10 South SLBM for the water requirements of 5 acres and 10 cows.

Water used by native vegetation on land is owned by the landowner no the State, because that water has never been available to the State to be granted to another party to diverted for any of that water for any described use.

There are Utah Supreme Court decisions confirming the above referenced in the attached pdf.

For example, a 20 acre-parcel has 1,000 trees, 1,000 bushes, grass, and flowers all consuming X-amount of water. That consumed X amount of water belongs to the landowner upon which the vegetation lives and never has been available to be diverted for any of Utah's 143,000 described water rights.

When a building foot print conserves water in excess of 173 gallons per day, then that lot should not be required to have a water permit for Domestic purposes. This is the case in Idaho and Nevada and other western states, because it's common sense and illegal to take native vegetation water from a land owner.

When a party "saves" water by lining a ditch cutting weed water and seepage, then that party is entitled to the water savings.

For example, when the Murdoch Canal was piped, the water saved was credited to the CUP. This same principle must apply to the small middle class land owners as it does to the billion dollar government water companies.

Utah must have principled based water laws and regulations applying to both the big and the small equally. Today, Utah's water regulations are anti-farmer and anti-private property right.

Please consider farmer water management style instead of the current water cartel water management style federalizing Utah's water and taking private property without just compensation.

Slowing the Flow of water paperwork by cutting State water management will create more private property rights, more wet water, and a better economy and society.
